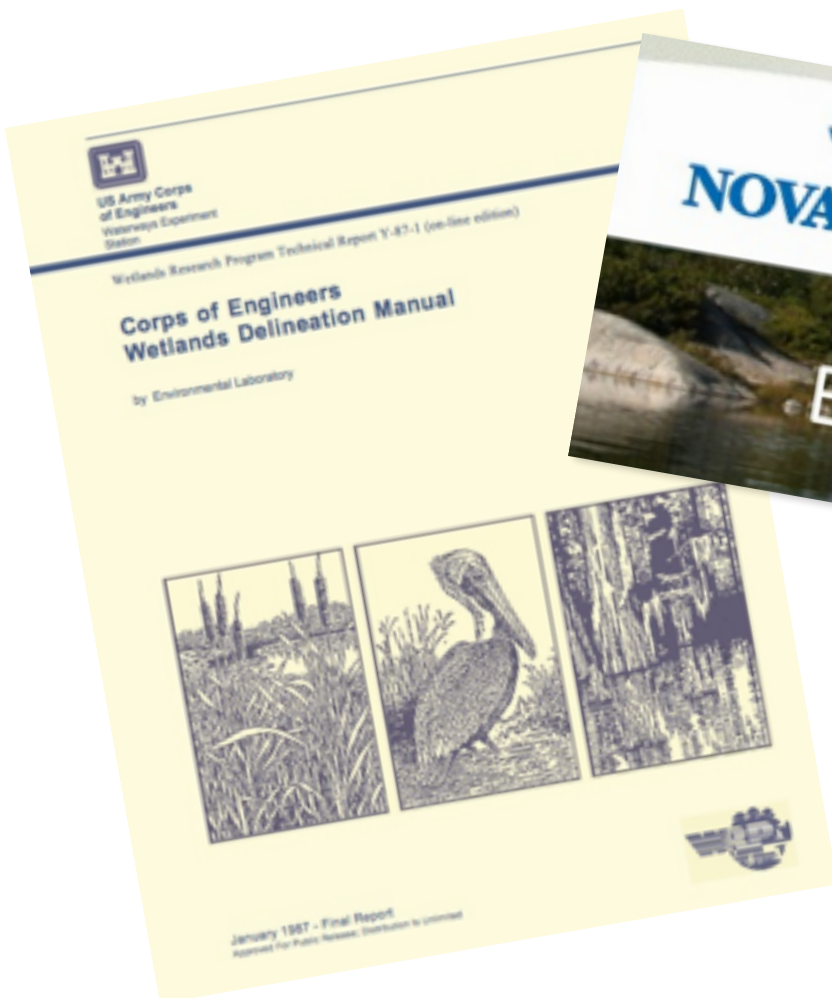




# Lunch & Learn
